Welcome to Pisces, version 3.1. Pisces is now in maintenance mode, which means most future changes will consist of small fixes and backend changes. The user experience is unchanged for this release.

Pisces is a web-enabled software application aimed at helping BPA and its Fish & Wildlife program participants track and manage projects throughout the Columbia River Basin. Pisces allows contractors and BPA project managers to collaborate on project definition and ongoing project management over the internet.

2. Author-Attachment rules loosened.

- Previously, the author of a contract attachment had to be a contact for that contract. That is no longer true. An author of an attachment may be any Pisces user, whether they are a contact on the contract in question or not.
