

# Release Notes for Pisces version 3.16

Welcome to the latest release of Pisces, version 3.16.

**Pisces** is a web-enabled .NET software application used by BPA and its Fish & Wildlife program participants to track and manage projects throughout the Columbia River Basin. Pisces allows contractors and BPA project managers to collaborate on project definition and ongoing project management over the internet.

Changes in this release include:

## **Initiation and Contract Delivery Workflow**

In My Stuff, you will now see new columns with summary detail on document approvals and submit actions for CRs and CCRs.

Also in My Stuff, a new “Amds” column (similar to the one already displayed on Explorer tab) displays the number of amendments and CCRs associated with a contract.

On the main workflow tab in Contract Details, all data is now automatically refreshed after any workflow action (such as approving a document or submitting/returning a CR).

## **RM&E Metadata**

You can now search the Data Repository Name field by entering text in the filter row.

## **End of the Current Capital Phase**

This release is the last in the current Capital Phase. Pisces now moves into O&M mode. Releases of new functionality will still occur, though at a slower pace than in the previous year.
